

The Ornament Project

The Medical Care for Children Partnership (MCCP) provides health care to qualified uninsured Fairfax County children. To raise money for these children, Herndon Friends Meeting (HFM) has been selling holiday ornaments since 1999, raising thousands of dollars. HFM's goal for 2007 is \$25,000.



2007 Ornament

Designed to symbolize light and hope, the ornaments depict inclusive symbols of light, such as stars, candles and lanterns, as well as more abstract renderings based on original interpretations by local, Northern Virginia-based artists.

The 2007 star design is made out of thin, reflective metal and is available in silver, gold and white. All proceeds (after a small deduction for materials) benefit MCCP.

Ornaments are fabricated by Pro-Type Industries of Sterling, Va., and painted by Independent Finishing Services of Manassas, Va.

Cost

The tax-deductible cost per ornament is \$15. Large, individual and small quantity orders are welcome. Discounts are available for larger orders.

Corporate donors are welcome to put their own logo on the gift boxes.

Delivery

For orders placed by Oct. 31, delivery is guaranteed by Thanksgiving. Orders placed after Oct. 31 will be filled as quickly as possible.
